SENATE BILL NO. 2073

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT DISSEMINATION OF VIOLENT VIDEO GAMES TO 1 CERTAIN MINORS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Selling or furnishing interactive violent video 4 games to juveniles. 5 As used in this section, the following words and phrases 6 (1)7 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection: 8 (a) "Entertainment Software Rating Board" means the 9 independent rating system established by the Interactive Digital Software Association developed to provide consumer information 10 11 regarding the content of video and computer software games and which may be found on the Internet at the Entertainment Software 12 Rating Board World Wide Web site. 13 (b) "Juvenile" means any person seventeen (17) years of 14 15 age or younger. (2) (a) A person commits an offense if the person sells, 16 rents or otherwise provides for use for a charge any video game to 17 a juvenile which has a "Mature (M)" or "Adult (A)" rating for 18 violence as determined by the Entertainment Software Rating Board 19 20 without the consent of the juvenile's parent, guardian or supervising family member over the age of eighteen (18). The 21 first violation of this subsection shall be a violation punishable 22 by a civil fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). 23 (b) A second or subsequent violation of this subsection 24

25 shall be a violation punishable by a civil fine of Five Hundred 26 Dollars (\$500.00).

(3) Any person or business offering any video game or 27 computer game for sale, loan, rental or use must make available 28 the most recent listings of the Entertainment Software Rating 29 Board for the inspection and review by any potential purchaser, 30 renter, user or transferee of such video or computer game. 31 Failure to make such information available shall constitute a 32 violation punishable by a civil fine of One Hundred Dollars 33 (100.00). 34

35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2003.
