- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. Every driver of a motor vehicle being operated in
- 5 forward motion on any public road, street or highway is prohibited
- 6 from carrying any passenger in a truck bed or in any open or
- 7 uncovered nonpassenger or cargo area which does not have a
- 8 passenger seat or seats manufactured or installed as an integral
- 9 part of the vehicle. A motor vehicle is a vehicle intended
- 10 primarily for use and operation on the public roads, streets and
- 11 highways and which is either self-propelled or is designed either
- 12 to be attached to or drawn by a self-propelled vehicle, but does
- 13 not include farm tractors and other machines and tools used in
- 14 production, harvesting and cultivation of farm products.
- 15 Violation of this section is a violation of the traffic
- 16 regulations and rules of the road and shall be punished as
- 17 provided in Section 63-9-11, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2003.
