43 any resident of the state who is on active duty with the United

44 States Army Special Forces, upon payment of the road and bridge

45 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as

prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 46 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 47 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 48 49 section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate 50 or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United States Army Special Forces. The distinctive license tags so 51 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax 52 Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or 53 numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license 54 55 tag.

56 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 57 58 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the distinctive license tag shall present proof of their active duty 59 membership in the United States Army Special Forces to the county 60 tax collector. The application and the additional fee imposed 61 under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to 62 63 be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. 64 65 The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund. 66

67 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or after July 1, 2003, any person applying for a distinctive license 68 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 69 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 70 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 71 72 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 73 74 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 75 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 76 77 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 78 If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license tag.

123 SECTION 2. Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

(1) For any distinctive license tag or plate 125 authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, through 126 June 30, 2002, the requirements of this subsection must be met 127 128 before the State Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate. The organization or other entity for which 129 the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate 130 must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at 131 least one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates will be 132 purchased and must deposit with the commission an amount necessary 133 to purchase one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. 134 The 135 organization or other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements 136 of this subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective 137 date of the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to 138 permit the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued. 139

140 (2) For any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by
141 the Legislature from and after July 1, 2002, the requirements of
142 this subsection must be met before the State Tax Commission may
143 prepare or issue any such license tag or plate. The organization

or other entity for which the Legislature authorized the 144 distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof satisfactory to 145 the State Tax Commission that at least two hundred (200) of such 146 147 license tags or plates will be purchased and must deposit with the 148 commission an amount necessary to purchase two hundred (200) of 149 such license tags or plates. The organization or other entity for 150 which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this subsection (2) within 151 three (3) years after the effective date of the law authorizing 152 the license tag or plate in order to permit the license tag or 153 154 plate to be prepared and issued.

(3) If the organization or other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this section, the State Tax Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive license tag or plate.

The State Tax Commission shall review the number of 160 (4)161 distinctive or special license tags or plates issued pursuant to this chapter during the period for the license tag or plate 162 163 series. If the number of any distinctive or special license tag or plate issued pursuant to this chapter falls below one hundred 164 165 (100) in the last year of the license tag or plate series, the distinctive or special license tag or plate shall be discontinued 166 at the end of the period for the license tag or plate series. 167 168 (5) If a distinctive or special license tag or plate is discontinued under subsection (4) of this section, the 169 organization or other entity for which the license tag or plate 170 was discontinued may prepare a distinctive or special license tag 171 or plate decal. The distinctive or special license tag or plate 172 decal shall be of such size, color and design as may be agreed 173 upon by the organization or other entity and the State Tax 174 175 Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall have final 176 approval of the size, color and design of the decal. The

177 distinctive or special license tag or plate decals shall be 178 prepared and sold by the organization or other entity, and the 179 proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by 180 the organization or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by 181 the organization or other entity.
