- SECTION 1. Section 27-103-153, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 27-103-153. Beginning with the 2004 fiscal year, the 8
- 9 appropriation bills enacted to provide funding for each state
- agency or institution may include performance targets for each 10
- performance measure established for each program within each such 11
- agency. Said performance targets may be established annually by 12
- the Legislature and, if established, shall be based upon the 13
- funding level authorized for each agency within its appropriation 14
- The Department of Finance and Administration shall provide 15
- 16 accounting system services to each agency to allow both program
- expenditures and performance measurement data to be maintained and 17
- reported in such form and in such detail as may be required by the 18
- Joint Legislative Budget Committee. 19
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2.0
- and after its passage. 21
