SENATE BILL NO. 2154

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOSEPH HARVEY OF  
2 JEFFERSON DAVIS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Joseph Harvey of Jefferson Davis County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction of the crime of robbery in 1994 in Jefferson Davis  
8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve twelve (12)  
9 years in the custody of the Department of Corrections. He was  
10 placed on parole on September 25, 1998, and discharged from parole  
11 on October 17, 1999. Since that time he has conducted himself as  
12 a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
14 and after its passage.
