SENATE BILL NO. 2186

AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 37-151-96, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO PROVIDE AN ALLOTMENT OF ADEQUATE EDUCATION PROGRAM FUNDS FOR
EMPLOYING PART-TIME LICENSED TEACHERS OR RETIRED TEACHERS; AND FOR
RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as

7 Section 37-151-96, Mississippi Code of 1972:

37-151-96. Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, in 8 9 addition to other funds allotted under this chapter, an amount subject to appropriation shall be provided to fund the cost of 10 salaries and fringe benefits of part-time licensed teachers or 11 part-time licensed retired teachers employed by the district for 12 any part of a school day in the elementary or secondary grades. 13 The State Board of Education shall prescribe the documentation 14 required from a school district on the necessity of employing such 15 16 part-time teachers or part-time licensed retired teachers, and the State Superintendent of Public Education must approve each 17 part-time teacher or part-time licensed retired teacher employed 18 by the district. From and after July 1, 2003, the State 19 Department of Education shall include the cost of employing 20 part-time licensed teachers or part-time licensed retired teachers 21 in its determination of base student cost under the adequate 22 23 education program.

24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 25 and after July 1, 2003.
