SENATE BILL NO. 2213

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-37-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REVISE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF RESTITUTION THAT CAN BE ORDERED BY A 2 3 JUSTICE COURT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 99-37-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6

99-37-3. (1) When a person is convicted of criminal 7 8 activities which have resulted in pecuniary damages, in addition to any other sentence it may impose, the court may order that the 9 defendant make restitution to the victim; provided, however, that 10 the justice court shall not order restitution in an amount 11 exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). 12

13 (2) In determining whether to order restitution which may be complete, partial or nominal, the court shall take into account: 14

15

The financial resources of the defendant and the (a) burden that payment of restitution will impose, with due regard to 16 the other obligations of the defendant; 17

18 (b) The ability of the defendant to pay restitution on an installment basis or on other conditions to be fixed by the 19 20 court; and

21 (C)The rehabilitative effect on the defendant of the payment of restitution and the method of payment. 22

If the defendant objects to the imposition, amount or 23 (3) distribution of the restitution, the court shall, at the time of 24 sentencing, allow him to be heard on such issue. 25

26 (4) If the court determines that restitution is inappropriate or undesirable, an order reciting such finding shall 27

28 be entered, which should also state the underlying circumstances 29 for such determination.

30 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after July 1, 2003.
