SENATE BILL NO. 2268

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-17-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 ELIMINATE THE PROVISION REQUIRING INSURANCE AGENTS TO EXHIBIT ON 3 DEMAND THEIR COMPANY APPOINTMENT CERTIFICATE WHEN SOLICITING 4 INSURANCE FOR AN INSURER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 83-17-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

83-17-5. Every agent of any insurance company, fraternal 8 order or association authorized to do business in this state shall 9 be required to obtain from the Commissioner of Insurance a 10 continuous certificate under the seal of his office showing that 11 the company for which he or she is licensed to do business in this 12 state, and that he or she is an agent of said company and duly 13 authorized to do business for it. Such certificate shall remain 14 valid as long as the insurance company, fraternal order or 15 16 association pays to the commissioner an annual certificate fee to continue the authorization. The insurance company, fraternal 17 order or association must notify the agent within thirty (30) days 18 if the authority is nonrenewed or cancelled. * * * 19

20 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 21 and after July 1, 2003.
