## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2313

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 37-9-105, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 37-9-105. In the event that a recommendation is made by the 8 9 school district not to offer an employee a renewal contract for a successive year, written notice of the proposed nonreemployment 10 stating the reasons for the proposed nonreemployment shall be 11 given no later than the following: 12 If the employee is a principal, the superintendent, (a) 13 without further board action, shall give notice of nonreemployment 14 on or before March 1; or 15 If the employee is a teacher, administrator or 16 (b) 17 other professional educator covered under Sections 37-9-101 through 37-9-113, the superintendent, without further board 18 action, shall give notice of nonreemployment on or before April 19 15; or 20 (c) If the employee is a state or federally-funded 21 teacher assistant, the superintendent, without further board 22 23 action, shall give notice of nonreemployment on or before May 1. An interim conservator appointed pursuant to the provisions 24 of Section 37-17-6(14)(a) or a school board acting on the 25 26 recommendation of a school district financial advisor appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 37-9-18 shall not be 27 required to comply with the time limitations prescribed in this 28 S.
