SENATE BILL NO. 2370

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION WITHOUT OBTAINING THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD AND NOTWITHSTANDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8 SECTION 1. Section 65-1-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:

10 65-1-9. The commission shall appoint an Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Transportation for a term of 11 office beginning on April 1, 1993. The person serving as 12 Executive Director of the State Highway Department on June 30, 13 1992, shall serve until April 1, 1993, as the Executive Director 14 of the Mississippi Department of Transportation, and thereafter 15 shall be eligible for reappointment to the position of Executive 16 Director of the Mississippi Department of Transportation. 17 Succeeding terms shall expire on April 1 each four (4) years 18 thereafter. The executive director may be removed by a majority 19 of the commission pursuant to Section 25-9-101 et seq., 20 Mississippi Code of 1972. All appointments by the commission 21 shall be with the advice and consent of the Senate. The 22 commission shall submit its appointment to the Senate not later 23 than March 1 of the year in which a term expires, and if such 24 submission is not made by March 1, the incumbent director shall be 25 deemed to have been reappointed for a four-year term. In the 26 27 event a vacancy occurs from resignation, death or removal from office by the commission, the commission shall submit its 28 appointment for the unexpired term to the Senate not later than 29 S. 30 the next March 1 after such vacancy occurs. If no appointment for 31 an unexpired term is submitted to the Senate, the Governor shall make such appointment not later than April 1 of such year. 32 The 33 commission shall fix the compensation of the executive director 34 based upon the qualifications of the executive director, notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 25-3-33 and 25-3-39. 35 The executive director shall be eligible for reappointment. 36 The executive director shall have the following qualifications: 37

38 (a) Possess a wide knowledge of the transportation39 system and needs of Mississippi;

40 (b) Possess a wide knowledge of the principles of41 transportation organization and administration; and

42 (c) Possess selected training or expertise in the field43 of transportation.

No person who is a member of the Mississippi Transportation 44 Commission, or who has been a member of the transportation 45 commission or of its predecessor, the State Highway Commission, 46 47 within two (2) years next preceding his appointment, shall be eligible to be chosen as executive director of the department. 48 49 The executive director shall be the executive officer of the commission and shall be subject to its orders and directions. 50 The 51 executive director shall give his entire time to the duties of his office. Before entering upon the duties of his office, the 52 executive director shall give bond to the State of Mississippi in 53 54 the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), conditioned upon the faithful discharge and performance of his official duty. The 55 principal and surety on such bond shall be liable thereunder to 56 the state for double the amount of value of any money or property 57 which the state may lose, if any, by reason of any wrongful or 58 criminal act of the executive director. Such bond, when approved 59 by the commission, shall be filed with the Secretary of State, and 60 61 the premium thereon shall be paid from any funds available to the
