- SECTION 1. Section 45-11-251, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 45-11-251. (1) There is hereby created the Mississippi Fire 8
- 9 Personnel Minimum Standards and Certification Board. The board
- shall consist of eight (8) members. The Commissioner of Insurance 10
- and the Director of the State Fire Academy shall serve as ex 11
- officio members. The Director of the State Fire Academy shall 12
- serve as secretary to the board. 13
- Six (6) members of the Mississippi Fire Personnel 14
- Minimum Standards and Certification Board shall be selected as 15
- 16 follows:
- (a) Three (3) full-time paid fire fighters below the 17
- rank of chief * * * selected by the Mississippi Fire Fighters 18
- Association; 19
- * * * 2.0
- (b) Three (3) fire chiefs * * * selected by the 21
- Mississippi Fire Chiefs Association. * * * 22
- The initial terms of members in each category selected in 23
- paragraphs (a) and (b) * * * shall be staggered: One (1) member 24
- in each category shall serve a term of one (1) year; one (1) 25
- 26 member in each category shall serve a term of two (2) years; one
- (1) member in each category shall serve a term of three (3) years. 27

- 28 After the expiration of the initial term, the term shall be three
- 29 (3) years.
- 30 * * *
- No member selected under this subsection shall serve more
- 32 than two (2) terms. Any member missing three (3) consecutive
- 33 meetings shall be deemed to have resigned from the board. A
- 34 vacancy prior to the expiration of a term shall be filled by
- 35 selection in the same manner and for the balance of the unexpired
- 36 term.
- 37 (3) During his term, a member of the board shall not serve
- 38 as a member of the State Fire Academy Advisory Board.
- 39 (4) The board shall select a chairman and vice chairman from
- 40 its membership.
- 41 (5) The Department of Insurance shall provide administrative

- 43 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2003.
