SENATE BILL NO. 2426

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-3-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR A FEMALE'S USE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE
- 3 RESULTING IN THE DEATH OF AN UNBORN FETUS OF 20 WEEKS OR MORE
- 4 GESTATIONAL AGE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 97-3-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 97-3-37. (1) The willful killing of an unborn quick child,
- 9 by an injury to the mother of such child, which would be murder if
- 10 it resulted in the death of the mother, shall be manslaughter.
- 11 (2) Any death of an unborn child of twenty (20) weeks or
- 12 more gestational age, resulting from the use by the mother of any
- 13 illegal controlled substance during the mother's pregnancy with
- the child in question, shall be manslaughter to be charged against
- 15 the mother. Any suspected such death shall be reported promptly
- 16 to the County Medical Examiner Investigator, who shall cause an
- 17 autopsy to be performed by a state-designated pathologist to
- 18 determine the cause and manner of death.

- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2003.
