## SENATE BILL NO. 2429

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-76, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE SALE OF COBIA CAUGHT IN MISSISSIPPI WATERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-15-76, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-15-76. (1) It is unlawful for any person to sell, barter
- 8 or trade or to offer for sale, barter or trade any game fish
- 9 enumerated in Chapter 15 of Title 49, Mississippi Code of 1972;
- 10 <u>except as provided under this section</u>.
- 11 (2) Cobia may be sold in this state \* \* \*. Any individual,
- 12 partnership, corporation or other entity which sells cobia in this
- 13 state shall maintain documentation showing the state of purchase
- 14 and date of purchase of cobia for a period of sixty (60) days from
- 15 the date of purchase of the cobia. The Department of Marine
- 16 Resources or any other law enforcement agency with which the
- 17 department has a cooperating agreement may require any seller of
- 18 cobia to document the date and state of purchase.
- 19 (3) Any person who cultivates a game fish as permitted under
- 20 the Mississippi Aquaculture Act of 1988 may sell the game fish in
- 21 accordance with the marine aquaculture program.
- 22 (4) A person who violates this section shall be punished as
- 23 provided in Section 49-15-63.
- 24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after July 1, 2003.
