## SENATE BILL NO. 2435

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 608, GENERAL LAWS OF 2000, TO 1 CONTINUE THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON GANG BEHAVIOR IN MISSISSIPPI; AND 2 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 608, General Laws of 2000, is amended as 5 follows: 6 Section 1. (1) There is hereby created a joint committee of 7 8 the Senate and House of Representatives to be known as the Joint Juvenile Justice Committee on Gang Behavior in Mississippi, 9 hereinafter referred to as the "committee." The committee shall 10 study and make recommendations to the Legislature related to the 11 coordination of policy to study, track, identify and develop 12 13 strategies for dealing with gangs and other groups that, as a group, engage in felonious criminal activity, and to study gangs, 14 gang violence and juvenile crimes. 15 (2) The committee shall consist of the following members: 16 The Chairmen and Vice Chairmen of the Senate 17 (a) Juvenile Justice Committee and the House Juvenile Justice 18 19 Committee. 20 (b) Three (3) members of the Senate appointed by the 21 Lieutenant Governor and three (3) members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House. 22 The Chairman of the Senate Juvenile Justice Committee 23 (3) shall serve as chair of the committee. 24 The committee may submit its findings and 25 (4)26 recommendations to the Legislature \* \* \*.

The members of the committee shall obtain the approval (5) 27 of the Management Committee of the House of Representatives and 28 the Rules Committee of the Senate for per diem and travel expense 29 30 expenditures of the committee. The members of the committee shall 31 not receive per diem or expenses while the Legislature is in session. All expenses incurred by and on behalf of the committee 32 shall be paid from the contingency funds of the Senate and the 33 House of Representatives. 34

35 (6) In conducting its activities pursuant to this act, the
36 committee may elicit the support of and participation by federal,
37 state and local agencies and interested associations,

38 organizations and individuals.

39 Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 40 and after July 1, 2000 \* \* \*.

41 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 42 and after its passage.
