SENATE BILL NO. 2440

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL "STOP CHILD ABUSE" MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAG; TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SUCH TAG SHALL BE DISBURSED TO THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF FAMILY SERVICES OFFICE OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE TAG WAS PURCHASED TO ASSIST IN

6 DEFRAYING THE COST OF PROGRAMS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 8 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 9 10 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 11 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 12 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 13 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor 14 vehicle registered in his name, which shall be produced in such 15 color and design as may be agreed upon by Pati Bannister and the 16

17 State Tax Commission. The words "Stop Child Abuse" shall be

18 centered at the bottom of the license tag. The State Tax

19 Commission shall prescribe such letters or numbers, or both, as

20 may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

21 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized

22 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms

23 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the

24 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less

25 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,

26 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis

27 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional

28 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the

29 county general fund.

- 30 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or after July 1, 2003, any person applying for a distinctive license 31 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 32 33 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 34 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 35 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 36 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 37 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 38 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 39 40 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 41 42 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 43
- 44 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
 45 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
 46 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
 47 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the
 48 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State
 49 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

- (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be distributed to the board of supervisors of the county in which the tag was purchased. The board of supervisors shall distribute such fees to the Department of Human Services, Division of Family and Child Services office of the county to assist in defraying the cost of the programs of such office.
- 57 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 58 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 59 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn 60 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- 61 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee

- 63 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
- 64 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
- 65 reconstruction of highways.
- (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 68 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 69 27-19-44.2.
- 70 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 71 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 72 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 73 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 74 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 75 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 76 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 77 tag.
- 78 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 79 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 80 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 81 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 82 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 83 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 84 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 85 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 86 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 87 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 88 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 89 and after July 1, 2003.
