- SECTION 1. This section shall be codified as Section 8
- 25-3-96, Mississippi Code of 1972: 9
- 10 25-3-96. Special leave without pay shall be granted for a
- period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the time of adoption to 11
- employees who are adoptive parents, upon written request, to the 12
- appointing authority, accompanied by a statement from the adoption 13
- agency indicating the required bonding period. Additional special 14
- leave may be granted by the appointing authority up to the 15
- remaining bonding period required by the adoption agency but not 16
- to exceed one (1) year. If the adoption process is not completed, 17
- the approval of leave shall be rescinded. This section shall not 18
- apply in cases of step-child or adult adoption. 19
