SENATE BILL NO. 2507

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 67-3-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 DEFINE THE TERM "BEER" FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE LAWS THAT LEGALIZE  
3 THE SALE OF LIGHT WINE AND BEER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 67-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
6 amended as follows:

7 67-3-3. When used in this chapter, unless the context  
8 indicates otherwise:

9 (a) \* \* \* "Commissioner" means the Chairman of the  
10 State Tax Commission of the State of Mississippi, and his  
11 authorized agents and employees;

12 (b) \* \* \* "Person" means one or more persons, a  
13 company, a corporation, a partnership, a syndicate or an  
14 association;

15 (c) \* \* \* "Manufacturer" and "retailer" include  
16 brewpubs licensed pursuant to Article 3, Chapter 71, Title 27,  
17 Mississippi Code of 1972, unless otherwise clearly provided; and

18 (d) "Beer" means a malt beverage as defined in the  
19 Federal Alcohol Administration Act and any rules and regulations  
20 adopted pursuant to such act.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
22 and after its passage.
