SENATE BILL NO. 2532

- AN ACT MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO KNOWINGLY SELL,
- 2 BARTER, EXCHANGE, DELIVER OR GIVE AWAY A BIDI CIGARETTE TO ANOTHER
- 3 PERSON; TO DEFINE THE TERM "BIDI CIGARETTE"; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** No person shall knowingly sell, barter, exchange,
- 7 deliver or give away a bidi cigarette to another person, nor shall
- 8 a person cause or permit or procure a bidi cigarette to be sold,
- 9 bartered, exchanged, delivered or given away to another person.
- 10 Any person who knowingly violates or knowingly causes the
- 11 violation of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor for
- 12 which the offender may be fined an amount as follows:
- 13 (a) For a first offense, not less than One Hundred
- 14 Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars
- 15 (\$500.00);
- 16 (b) For a second offense within a two-year period, not
- 17 less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) and not more than
- 18 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00);
- 19 (c) For a third or subsequent offense within a two-year
- 20 period, not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and not more
- 21 than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
- 22 For purposes of this section, the term "bidi cigarette" means
- 23 a product that contains tobacco that is wrapped in temburni leaf
- 24 (diospyros melanoxylon) or tendu leaf (diospyros exculpra) or that
- 25 is wrapped in another material identified by rules of the State
- 26 Department of Health that is similar in appearance or
- 27 characteristics to the temburni or tendu leaf.

28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

29 and after July 1, 2003.
