1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REMOVE THE ALTERNATIVE FOR SURETY BOND REQUIREMENT FOR WILDLIFE 3 LICENSE AGENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 49-7-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

49-7-17. (1) The department may provide for the appointment
of persons as license agents to sell license certificates for
hunting, trapping or fishing as authorized under Section 49-7-21.

10 The department may, by administrative rule, establish 11 qualifications, standards and regulations for such license agents.

12 (2) Each license agent shall be required to be covered under 13 a surety bond. The department may establish, by administrative 14 rule, the procedures for the bonding of its license agents, which 15 procedures may include the implementation of a blanket bonding 16 system. All premiums for surety bonds required under this section 17 shall be at the expense of the license agents. * * *

Any officer or person authorized to issue any hunting or 18 (3) fishing license or permit or any combination game and fish license 19 20 under the laws of this state shall have the power and authority to 21 collect and retain for the issuance of such license the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), in addition to the license fee provided by law, 22 when such license or permit is sold to a resident of this state. 23 The Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks is authorized, in 24 its discretion, to contract with license agents for services 25 rendered for an additional amount, not to exceed One Dollar 26 27 (\$1.00), in addition to the license fee provided by law.
