SENATE BILL NO. 2610

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-46-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REINSTATE SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 11-46-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 11-46-1. As used in this chapter, the following terms shall
- 8 have the meanings herein ascribed unless the context otherwise
- 9 requires:
- 10 (a) "Claim" means any demand to recover damages from a
- 11 governmental entity as compensation for injuries.
- 12 (b) "Claimant" means any person seeking compensation
- 13 under the provisions of this chapter, whether by administrative
- 14 remedy or through the courts.
- 15 (c) "Board" means the Mississippi Tort Claims Board.
- 16 (d) "Department" means the Department of Finance and
- 17 Administration.
- 18 (e) "Director" means the executive director of the
- 19 department who is also the executive director of the board.
- 20 (f) "Employee" means any officer, employee or servant
- 21 of the State of Mississippi or a political subdivision of the
- 22 state, including elected or appointed officials and persons acting
- 23 on behalf of the state or a political subdivision in any official
- 24 capacity, temporarily or permanently, in the service of the state
- 25 or a political subdivision whether with or without compensation.
- 26 The term "employee" shall not mean a person or other legal entity
- 27 while acting in the capacity of an independent contractor under

- 28 contract to the state or a political subdivision; provided,
- 29 however, that for purposes of the limits of liability provided for
- 30 in Section 11-46-15, the term "employee" shall include physicians
- 31 under contract to provide health services with the State Board of
- 32 Health, the State Board of Mental Health or any county or
- 33 municipal jail facility while rendering services under such
- 34 contract. The term "employee" shall also include any physician,
- 35 dentist or other health care practitioner employed by the
- 36 University of Mississippi Medical Center (UMMC) and its
- 37 departmental practice plans who is a faculty member and provides
- 38 health care services only for patients at UMMC or its affiliated
- 39 practice sites. The term "employee" shall also include any
- 40 physician, dentist or other health care practitioner employed by
- 41 any university under the control of the Board of Trustees of State
- 42 Institutions of Higher Learning who practices only on the campus
- 43 of any university under the control of the Board of Trustees of
- 44 State Institutions of Higher Learning. The term "employee" shall
- 45 also include any physician, dentist or other health care
- 46 practitioner employed by the State Veterans Affairs Board and who
- 47 provides health care services for patients for the State Veterans
- 48 Affairs Board. The term "employee" shall also include Mississippi
- 49 Department of Human Services licensed foster parents for the
- 50 limited purposes of coverage under the Tort Claims Act as provided
- 51 in Section 11-46-8.
- 52 (g) "Governmental entity" means and includes the state
- 53 and political subdivisions as herein defined.
- (h) "Injury" means death, injury to a person, damage to
- or loss of property or any other injury that a person may suffer
- 56 that is actionable at law or in equity.
- 57 (i) "Political subdivision" means any body politic or
- 58 body corporate other than the state responsible for governmental
- 59 activities only in geographic areas smaller than that of the
- 60 state, including, but not limited to, any county, municipality,

- * * * community hospital as defined in Section 41-13-10,
- 62 Mississippi Code of 1972, airport authority or other
- 63 instrumentality thereof, whether or not such body or
- 64 instrumentality thereof has the authority to levy taxes or to sue
- or be sued in its own name; "political subdivision" does not mean
- 66 a school district.
- (j) "State" means the State of Mississippi and any
- 68 office, department, agency, division, bureau, commission, board,
- 69 institution, hospital, college, university, airport authority or
- 70 other instrumentality thereof, whether or not such body or
- 71 instrumentality thereof has the authority to levy taxes or to sue
- 72 or be sued in its own name.
- 73 (k) "Law" means all species of law including, but not
- 74 limited to, any and all constitutions, statutes, case law, common
- 75 law, customary law, court order, court rule, court decision, court
- 76 opinion, court judgment or mandate, administrative rule or
- 77 regulation, executive order, or principle or rule of equity.
- 78 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after July 1, 2003.
