SENATE BILL NO. 2671

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A BUSINESS FROM USING NONORIGINAL
 2 EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER AFTERMARKET CRASH PARTS ON ANY MOTOR
 3 VEHICLE WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE OWNER
 4 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE AT THE TIME OF REPAIR AUTHORIZATION; AND FOR
 5 RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** A business may not authorize or require the use
 8 of a nonoriginal equipment manufacturer aftermarket crash part on
 9 any motor vehicle without first obtaining the written consent of
 10 the owner of the motor vehicle at the time of repair
 11 authorization, verifiable by the owner's signature on a separate
 12 consent form prepared by the Attorney General's Office of Consumer
 13 Protection.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
 15 and after July 1, 2003.
