SENATE BILL NO. 2754

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-101-27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO EXTEND THE DATE BY WHICH THE AYERS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT MUST BE 3 FINALIZED IN ORDER FOR THE AYERS SETTLEMENT FUND TO BE CREATED IN 4 THE STATE TREASURY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-101-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 37-101-27. (1) There is created within the Working 9 Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund in the State Treasury a trust to 10 be known as the Ayers Endowment Trust, which shall be used as 11 provided in this section. On July 1, 1997, Fifteen Million 12 Dollars (\$15,000,000.00) in the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve 13 Fund shall be set aside and placed in the Ayers Endowment Trust.

14 (2) The principal of the Ayers Endowment Trust shall remain
15 inviolate within the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund, and
16 shall be invested in the same manner as the remainder of the
17 Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund.

The interest and income earned from the investment of 18 (3) 19 the principal of the Ayers Endowment Trust shall be appropriated by the Legislature to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions 20 of Higher Learning for the benefit of Jackson State University, 21 Alcorn State University and Mississippi Valley State University, 22 the historically black institutions of higher learning in 23 Mississippi, with one-third (1/3) of the amount of the interest 24 and income earned being allocated for the benefit of each of those 25 universities. The money allotted for each university shall be 26 used for continuing educational enhancement and racial diversity, 27

28 including recruitment of white students and scholarships for white 29 applicants.

The creation of the Ayers Endowment Trust and the 30 (4) appropriation of the interest and income for the purposes 31 32 specified in this section shall be to comply with the order of the United States District Court in the case of Ayers v. Fordice, 879 33 F.Supp. 1419 (N.D. Miss. 1995), with regard to Jackson State 34 University and Alcorn State University, and to provide Mississippi 35 Valley State University with an equal amount of funding for the 36 37 same purposes as for the other historically black institutions of higher learning. 38

(5) If the United States District Court for the Northern 39 40 District of Mississippi approves and directs the implementation of a settlement agreement in the case of Ayers v. Musgrove (Civil 41 Action No. 4:75CV9-B-D, in the United States District Court for 42 the Northern District of Mississippi), and if the agreement 43 becomes final and effective according to its terms (including, but 44 45 not limited to, the exhaustion of all rights of appeal) before the first day of the 2004 Regular Session of the Legislature, there 46 47 shall be created in the State Treasury a fund to be known as the Monies deposited into the Ayers Settlement 48 Ayers Settlement Fund. 49 Fund under Section 27-103-203(2) shall be appropriated by the Legislature to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of 50 Higher Learning for the purpose of establishing a public endowment 51 52 for the benefit of Jackson State University, Alcorn State University and Mississippi Valley State University in compliance 53 54 with the settlement agreement.

(6) If the Ayers Settlement Fund is created under subsection
(5) of this section, subsection (1) through (4) of this section
shall be repealed when the Ayers Endowment Trust reaches Zero
Dollars (\$0.00) in accordance with Section 27-103-203(3).

59 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 60 and after its passage.
