SENATE BILL NO. 2765

- AN ACT TO CREATE A POULTRY GROWERS GRIEVANCE BOARD; TO PROVIDE FOR GRIEVANCES TO BE HEARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 5 Mississippi Poultry Growers Grievance Act.
- 6 **SECTION 2.** As used in this act:
- 7 (a) "Board" means the Poultry Growers Grievance Review
- 8 Board created in this act.
- 9 (b) "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the
- 10 Department of Agriculture and Commerce.
- 11 (c) "Department" means the Mississippi Department of
- 12 Agriculture and Commerce.
- 13 (d) "Grower" means a person who grows, raises or
- 14 produces poultry or poultry products and contracts with a
- 15 processor to provide management, labor, machinery, facilities or
- 16 any other production input for the production of poultry or
- 17 poultry products.
- 18 (e) "Person" means any individual, partnership,
- 19 association, corporation, limited liability company, or any other
- 20 legal entity.
- 21 (f) "Processor" means a person who in the ordinary
- 22 course of business, buys poultry or poultry products grown, raised
- 23 or produced in this state or who contracts with a grower to grow,
- 24 raise or produce poultry or poultry products in this state.
- 25 <u>SECTION 3.</u> There is hereby created the Mississippi Poultry
- 26 Growers Grievance Review Board with domicile at the capital city
- 27 of the state. The board shall be composed of six (6) members:

- 28 one (1) member shall be the Commissioner of Agriculture and
- 29 Commerce as ex officio member. One (1) member shall be appointed
- 30 from each congressional district and the remainder from the state
- 31 at large. The commissioner shall appoint the members to terms of
- 32 one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) years,
- 33 respectively, so as to stagger the terms. After the expiration of
- 34 the initial terms, the terms shall be for four (4) years. Each
- 35 member shall serve, after the completion of his term, until his
- 36 successor is appointed and duly qualified. Each vacancy shall be
- 37 filled by appointment for the unexpired term.
- 38 SECTION 4. The powers and duties of the board shall include,
- 39 but be not limited to, the following:
- 40 (a) To hear grievances of growers and producers. The
- 41 grievance procedure shall be voluntary.
- 42 (b) All material, data and information received by the
- 43 board with respect to any grievance filed under this act are
- 44 confidential and not subject to the Public Records Act. No
- 45 official or employee of the board may knowingly disclose any such
- 46 information without the consent of the parties involved.
- 47 (d) The state shall bear the cost of the grievance
- 48 process including the cost of all meetings.
- (e) Each session of the grievance process shall be
- 50 scheduled in a timely manner and shall be held in a location
- 51 convenient to the parties involved.
- 52 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 53 and after July 1, 2003.
