## SENATE BILL NO. 2768

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT STATE REGULATIONS GOVERNING FREE RANGE
- 2 POULTRY SHALL BE NO MORE STRINGENT THAN FEDERAL REGULATIONS ON

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) Any regulations or best management practices
- 6 adopted by the Commissioner of Agriculture regulating free range
- 7 poultry shall be no more stringent or extensive in scope,
- 8 coverage, or effect than federal regulations and best management
- 9 practices.
- 10 (2) If federal regulations or recommended best management
- 11 practices do not address a matter relating to free range poultry,
- 12 the Commissioner of Agriculture may adopt regulations or best
- 13 management practices necessary to protect human health, safety or
- 14 the environment.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 2003.
