- 5 **SECTION 1.** Any regulations or best management practices
- 6 adopted by the Commissioner of Agriculture regulating free-range
- 7 poultry only shall be no more stringent or extensive in scope,
- 8 coverage, or effect than federal regulations and best management
- 9 practices. For purposes of this section, "free-range poultry"
- 10 means poultry having free access to the outdoors through their
- 11 normal growing cycle.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after July 1, 2003.
