SENATE BILL NO. 2800

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-43-24, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PLACE 3 TEXTBOOK, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLY ORDERS FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING 4 SCHOOLS ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION PRIOR TO THE 5 BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH FUNDS ARE APPROPRIATED FOR 6 SUCH PURPOSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 37-43-24, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

10 37-43-24. (1) This section shall be referred to and may be 11 cited as the "Timely Acquisition of Braille and Large Print 12 Textbooks Act of 2002."

The State Department of Education is hereby authorized 13 (2)and directed to place textbook procurement orders for visually 14 impaired and hearing impaired students in the schools of this 15 state prior to the beginning of the fiscal year for which the 16 expenditure for such order has been authorized by the Legislature. 17 After June 1 of any year, the State Department of Education may 18 order additional books, as needed. In addition, the State 19 Department of Education is authorized and directed to place 20 textbook, equipment and school supply procurement orders for 21 students attending the state supported schools administered by the 22 State Board of Education prior to the beginning of the fiscal year 23 24 for which the expenditure for such order has been authorized by the Legislature, and may order additional books, equipment and 25 supplies at a later date, as needed. The department shall insure 26 that the appropriate procedures for textbook procurement are 27 followed according to state law and board policy as described in 28 the Textbook Administration Handbook. 29
