- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-41-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR CRUEL TREATMENT AND MALICIOUS INJURY OF 2

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 97-41-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 97-41-15. (1) Any person who shall maliciously, either out
- 8 of a spirit of revenge or wanton cruelty, or who shall
- mischievously kill, maim or wound, or injure any animal, or cause 9
- any person to do the same, shall be guilty of a felony and upon 10
- conviction, shall be committed to the custody of the State 11
- Department of Corrections for not less than twelve (12) months nor 12
- 13 more than five (5) years, and fined an amount not less than One
- Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), nor more than Ten 14
- Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). 15
- In addition to any such fine or imprisonment which may 16
- be imposed, the court shall order that restitution be made to the 17
- owner of any animal injured by a violation of subsection (1) of 18
- this section. The measure for restitution in money shall be the 19
- current replacement value of such loss and/or the actual 20
- 21 veterinarian fees, special supplies, loss of income and other
- costs incurred as a result of actions in violation of subsection 22
- (1) of this section. 23
- (3) For purposes of this section, the term "animal" means 24
- exotic animals, horses, mules, cattle, swine, sheep, felines, 25
- 26 canines and other domestic animals * * *.

- 27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after its passage.
