## SENATE BILL NO. 2859

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 39-5-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT APPOINTMENTS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE

- DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY SHALL BE MADE BY THE GOVERNOR FROM THE FOUR MISSISSIPPI CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS ON A PHASED-IN 4
- BASIS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 39-5-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- 39-5-3. The Department of Archives and History shall be 9
- under the control of a board of nine (9) trustees. The board 10
- shall have the power and authority to fill all vacancies occurring 11
- therein, whether by expiration of term of service or by death or 12
- resignation, but the names of all newly elected members shall be 13
- 14 communicated to the next ensuing session of the State Senate for
- confirmation \* \* \*. The members of the board of trustees as 15
- constituted on January 1, 2003, whose terms have not expired shall 16
- serve the balance of their terms, after which time the membership 17
- of the board of trustees shall be appointed as follows: The 18
- Governor shall appoint two (2) members of the board of trustees 19
- from each of the four (4) Mississippi congressional districts as 20
- they currently exist and one (1) from the state at large, with 21
- 22 the advice and consent of the Senate, with the congressional
- districts to be designated at the time of appointment, and the 23
- Governor shall make appointments from the congressional district 24
- having the smallest number of board members until the membership 25
- includes two (2) members from each congressional district as 26
- 27 required. All trustees chosen to succeed the present members or
- their successors shall serve for a term of six (6) years; 28

- 29 provided, however, that trustees appointed after January 1, 2003,
- 30 shall serve for a term of four (4) years. The board of trustees
- 31 shall hold at the State Capitol at least one (1) regular meeting
- 32 during the year, and as many special meetings as may be necessary,
- 33 and at said meetings five (5) members shall constitute a quorum.
- 34 The Director of the Department of Archives and History,
- 35 hereinafter provided, shall be secretary of the board. The
- 36 trustees shall receive no compensation for their services other
- 37 than the amount of their necessary expenses actually paid out
- 38 while in attendance on the meetings of the board or the business
- 39 of the department. The board is empowered to adopt rules for its
- 40 own government and for the government of the department, to elect
- 41 and fix the compensation of a director not to exceed the maximum
- 42 set by the Legislature, and other officials or employees, and to
- 43 do and perform such other acts and things as may be necessary to
- 44 carry out the true intent and purposes of this chapter.
- 45 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 46 and after its passage.
