SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 29 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 30 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 31 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 32 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 33 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 34 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after July 1, 2003. 36
