AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 5 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the 6 7 expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal 8 year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 9\$ 18,686,102.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 10 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 11 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or 12 the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the 13 expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the 14 authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending 15 June 30, 2004..... \$ 151,064,702.00. 16 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 17 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 18 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 19 20 Permanent: Full Time..... 294 Part Time..... 21 2 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 22 30 23 Part Time..... 1 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 24 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 25 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 26 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 27 S. 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funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 28 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 29 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 31 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 34 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 35 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 36 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 37 38 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 39 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 40 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 41 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 42 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 43 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 44

45 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 46 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

51 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 52 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall 53 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray 54 the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in operating 55 the state welcome centers.

56 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 57 Section 2, Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) shall be derived 58 from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, 59 Mississippi Code of 1972.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 78 79 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 80 81 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 82 Year 2003. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 83 84 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2005 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 85 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 86 provided during the Fiscal Year 2004 budget request process. 87

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, the amount of Four Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$4,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2004. The expenditure

SECTION 15. None of the funds appropriated in Section 2 shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate representing such districts are notified at least five (5) days prior to the awarding of Community Development Block Grants or any other grants to their districts.

SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for the health insurance plan.

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SECTION 17. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 190 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 191 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 192 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 193 194 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 195 SECTION 18. This act shall take effect and be in force from 196 and after July 1, 2003. 197
