BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission 8 9 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Mississippi Fair Commission, the Mississippi Livestock Coliseum, the Industrial 10 Showcase, the Trade Mart Building and for the purpose of paying 11 any indebtedness which may accrue for the period beginning 12 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 13 4,052,887.00. SECTION 2. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 36 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 37 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 38 39 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 40 41 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 43 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 44 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 45 46 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 47 48 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 49 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 53 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 54

55 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 56 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

57 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 58 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 59 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 60 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

No operation, maintenance or service contracts, 62 agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or 63 catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency 64 for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said 65 contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance 66 with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi 67 Code of 1972.

68 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 69 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for 70 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance 71 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and 72 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for 73 the health insurance plan.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 74 75 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 77 78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 79 80 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2003. 81
