6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State
9	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
10	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management
11	Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et
12	seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning
13	July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004 \$ 787,529.00.
14	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
15	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
16	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
17	Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source
18	funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the
19	support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year
20	beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004

22	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
23	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall

47	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
48	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
49	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004
50	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
51	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the
52	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
53	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
54	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

208	matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the
209	state.
210	SECTION 21. It is the intention of the Legislature that none
211	of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for
212	increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance
213	Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and
214	Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for
215	the health insurance plan.
216	SECTION 22. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by
217	this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be
218	paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General
219	Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon
220	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
221	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
222	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
223	SECTION 23. This act shall take effect and be in force from
224	and after July 1, 2003.
