- 68 (\$152,750.00) and three (3) full-time positions are provided to
- 69 carry out the provisions of House Bill No. 1414, Regular Session
- 70 of 2003, or Senate Bill No. 2414, Regular Session of 2003. In the
- 71 event that House Bill No. 1414, Regular Session of 2003, or Senate
- 72 Bill No. 2414, Regular Session of 2003, is not enacted into law,
- 73 it is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of
- 74 Banking and Consumer Finance shall not expend One Hundred Fifty-
