5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much there	of as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money i	n the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Boar	d of Pharmacy,
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred b	y said board
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and endi	ng
10	June 30, 2004\$	873,615.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the	provisions of

31	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
32	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
33	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
34	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004
35	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
36	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the
37	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
38	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
39	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
40	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
41	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
42	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
43	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal
44	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
45	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
46	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
47	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"
48	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
49	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
50	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
51	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
52	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
53	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
54	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
55	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
56	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
57	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
58	SECTION 3. Of the funds provided under the provisions of
59	this act, Three Thousand Fifty-one Dollars (\$3,051.00) may be used
60	to reallocate or reclassify existing positions of this agency.

61	SECTION 4. In addition to all other funds heretofore
62	appropriated, the following sum is hereby appropriated out of any
63	money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State
64	Board of Pharmacy for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
65	Board for the period beginning upon passage and through June 30,
66	2004\$ 300,000.00.
67	With the funds appropriated under the provisions of this
68	Section, it is the intention of the Legislature that the
69	Mississippi State Board of Pharmacy, acting through and under the
70	direction of and with the approval of the Department of Finance
71	and Administration, may negotiate a contract or agreement to
72	secure property and construct a building that may be suitable for
73	serving as a headquarters facility for the Mississippi State Board
74	of Pharmacy.
75	SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
76	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
77	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
78	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
79	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
80	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
81	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
82	and after July 1, 2003, except for Section 4 which shall take
83	effect and be in force from and after its passage.
