## SENATE BILL NO. 2996

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ANY SPOUSE WHO RECEIVED A SPOUSE 2 RETIREMENT BENEFIT FROM THE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND FOR FIREMEN 3 AND POLICEMEN OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, BEFORE JULY 4 1, 2003, AND WHOSE BENEFITS WERE TERMINATED BECAUSE OF REMARRIAGE, 5 TO AGAIN RECEIVE HIS OR HER SPOUSE RETIREMENT BENEFIT; AND FOR 6 RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** (1) Subject to the provisions of subsections (2) 8 and (3) of this section, the governing authorities of the City of 9 10 Vicksburg, Mississippi, may authorize any spouse who received a spouse retirement benefit under the provisions of Sections 11 21-29-145 and 21-29-147, Mississippi Code of 1972, from the 12 Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen of the City 13 of Vicksburg before July 1, 2003, and whose benefits were 14 terminated because of remarriage, to again receive his or her 15 spouse retirement benefit from and after making application with 16 the board of trustees to reinstate the spouse retirement benefit. 17 Any reinstatement of the spouse retirement benefit shall be 18 prospective only from and after the first of the month following 19 the date of application for reinstatement. 20

(2) The spouse retirement benefits authorized under 21 subsection (1) of this section shall not be reinstated unless the 22 Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen of the City 23 of Vicksburg is actuarially sound, as shown by the most recent 24 actuarial study required by Section 21-29-119, Mississippi Code of 25 1972, and unless the fund will remain actuarially sound if the 26 27 spouse retirement benefits are reinstated as authorized under subsection (1) of this section, as shown by a certified statement 28

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29 from the actuarial firm that prepared the most recent actuarial 30 study.

(3) After the governing authorities of the City of Vicksburg 31 32 have adopted a resolution to reinstate the spouse retirement 33 benefits authorized under subsection (1) of this section and the advisory board provided for in Section 21-29-105, Mississippi Code 34 of 1972, has adopted a resolution supporting the reinstatement of 35 the benefits, and after the Board of Trustees of the Public 36 Employees' Retirement System has received these resolutions and 37 received the most recent actuarial study of the disability and 38 39 relief fund and the certified statement from the actuarial firm that the fund will remain actuarially sound if the benefits are 40 reinstated, then, after receipt of the required application for 41 reinstatement, the board of trustees shall begin paying the spouse 42 retirement benefits as provided in subsection (1) of this section. 43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 45 and after its passage.
