SENATE BILL NO. 3023

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COAHOMA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, OR ANY AGENCY, AUTHORITY OR DISTRICT SESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, TO ENGAGE IN UTILITY, PUBLIC WORKS AND OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS AND TO EXPEND PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THESE PROJECTS NECESSARY FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 **SECTION 1.** As used in this act, the following words and 9 phrases shall have the following meanings unless the context 10 clearly indicates otherwise:

(a) "Agency" means the Coahoma County Economic
Development District, the Industrial Development Authority of
Coahoma County, Mississippi, or any agency, authority or district
established by the Board of Supervisors of Coahoma County,
Mississippi, for the purpose of securing, promoting or furthering
economic or industrial development of Coahoma County, Mississippi.

"Board of Supervisors" means the Board of

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18 Supervisors of Coahoma County, Mississippi.

(b)

"Project" means the construction, repair or 19 (C) 20 extension of streets, roads, waterworks, water supply facilities, sewerage and sewer collection and disposal facilities, drainage 21 improvements, pollution control facilities and other facilities or 22 infrastructure necessary, required or in furtherance of industrial 23 24 or economic development within Coahoma County, Mississippi, both within and outside the municipalities located within the county. 25 **SECTION 2.** (1) The board of supervisors or any agency, upon 26

approval and authorization by the board of supervisors, may engage alone or jointly with others in a project and provide funds,

29 labor, equipment and in-kind services for the project. The amount S. B. No. 3023 03/SS02/R1216
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and type of funding and support provided to any project by the 30 board of supervisors shall be determined by resolution duly 31 adopted and spread on the minutes of the board of supervisors. 32 33 The amount and type of funding and support provided by any agency 34 to any project shall be determined by the agency by resolution 35 duly adopted and spread on the agency's minutes and approved by the board of supervisors. The board of supervisors may 36 appropriate funds to a project, and any agency, upon the approval 37 of the board of supervisors, may appropriate funds to the project. 38 The board of supervisors and any agency, with the approval of the 39 40 board of supervisors, may provide any type of funding and support to a project or to any governmental agency authorized by law to 41 own, operate, control or maintain the facilities or infrastructure 42 which constitute the project. 43

The board of supervisors and any agency, with the (2) 44 45 approval of the board of supervisors, may apply for and accept, receive, disburse and expend federal and state funds and any other 46 47 funds, public or private, which may become available by grant, donation, loan, the issuance of bonds or otherwise, for the 48 49 purpose of construction, maintenance and improvements of a project. All federal funds accepted under this section shall be 50 accepted and expended by the board of supervisors or the agency 51 upon terms and conditions as are prescribed by the United States 52 and as are consistent with state law. All state funds accepted 53 54 under this section shall be accepted and expended by the board of supervisors or the agency upon terms and conditions as prescribed 55 56 by the state.

57 (3) The board of supervisors and any agency may execute any 58 agreements, contracts and documents and do and perform any other 59 acts necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.

(4) The board of supervisors or any agency, with the
approval of the board of supervisors, may expend public funds
available to it to promote and solicit new business and industry

provide services which will insure the continued economic
development in the county. The board of supervisors, or any
agency, with the approval of the board of supervisors, may further
expend funds to remove obstacles to the development of new
business and industry within Coahoma County, Mississippi.
SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
