7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the Town of Oakland,
9	Mississippi, in their discretion, may borrow money in an aggregate
10	amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)
11	for the purpose of financing, refinancing, purchasing and/or
12	equipping a fire truck or financing, refinancing and/or purchasing
13	fire suppression equipment, or both, for use in providing fire
14	protection services. Before any money may be borrowed under this
15	section, the governing authorities shall adopt a resolution
16	declaring the necessity for such borrowing and specifying the
