SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 534

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 36,
- 2 MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO PROVIDE THAT ALL REGULAR
- 3 LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS SHALL BE 90 DAYS.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 5 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 6 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 7 state:
- 8 Amend Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 Section 36. The Legislature shall meet at the seat of
- 11 government in regular session on the Tuesday after the first
- 12 Monday of January * * * and the regular session shall be limited
- 13 to a period of * * * ninety (90) calendar days * * *. The House
- 14 of Representatives, by resolution with the Senate concurring
- 15 therein, and by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present and
- 16 voting in each house, may extend such limited session for a period
- 17 of thirty (30) days with no limit on the number of extensions to
- 18 each session.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on
- 21 the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2003 as
- 22 provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of the amendment
- 24 for the ballot shall read as follows: "This amendment eliminates
- 25 the 120-day regular session after the statewide general election
- 26 and provides that all regular session shall be for 90 days."
