- 7 WHEREAS, Jackson Touchdown Club and Mississippi Sports Hall
- 8 of Fame has unveiled the Class of 2003 of the Mississippi Sports
- 9 Hall of Fame, which features Jackie Slater, Pro Football Hall of
- 10 Fame member who is a native of Jackson, Mississippi, and was a
- 11 durable All-American at Jackson State University and an All-Pro
- 12 offensive lineman for the NFL's Los Angeles and St. Louis Rams;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, Jackie Slater attended Blackburn Junior High, Jim
- 15 Hill High School, and Wingfield High School before playing for
- 16 Jackson State from 1972-1975, he was named first team All-American
- 17 by the Pittsburg Courier in 1975, he blocked for fellow Pro
- 18 Football Hall Of Fame and Mississippi Hall Of Fame member, Walter
- 19 Payton, at Jackson State University; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Jackie Slater was a 3rd round draft choice, 86th
- 21 pick overall, by the Los Angles Rams in the 1976 National Football
- 22 League Draft, played for the Rams in Los Angles and St. Louis
- 23 from 1976-1995 and set team records for most seasons played (20),
- 24 most games played in a career (259), and most career postseason
- 25 games played (18); and
- 26 WHEREAS, he holds the National Football League record for
- 27 most seasons played with the same club (20), fourth on National
- 28 Football League all-time participation chart behind Jan Stenerud,
- 29 Jim Marshall, and George Blanda, Slater blocked in 107 different

- 30 100 yards rushing games and 27 different 300 yard passing games,
- 31 he cleared the way for 7 different 1,000 yard rushers, paved a
- 32 path for 23 different quarterbacks and 36 different running backs;
- 33 and
- 34 WHEREAS, Jackie Slater was named All-Pro on 5 occasions and
- 35 played in 7 Pro Bowls, he was inducted into the Pro Football Hall
- 36 of Fame in his first year of eligibility in 2001 and into the
- 37 Jackson State Athletic Hall of Fame the same year.
- 38 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
- 39 outstanding athlete who has brought honor to his university and to
- 40 the State of Mississippi:
