- WHEREAS, since the events of 9/11 and the anthrax attacks in
- 15 2001, the Emergency Services Branch responders have served as the
- 16 state's frontline defense to incidents involving any potential
- 17 biological or chemical acts of terrorism; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Branch, coordinating with
- 19 other state agencies, has handled hundreds of responses to white
- 20 powder scares and other potential biological/chemical acts of
- 21 terrorism; and
- 22 WHEREAS, in addition to working closely with both state and
- 23 federal agencies, the Emergency Services Branch works very closely
- 24 with local governmental entities, such as county emergency
- 25 management agencies, hazardous materials teams, fire departments,
- 26 law enforcement and health officials; and

27	WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Branch is particularly known					
28	for its commitment to assist our state's industries when they are					
29	involved with accidental spills or releases of hazardous					
30	substances; and
