- WHEREAS, since the events of 9/11 and the anthrax attacks in 14
- 15 2001, the Emergency Services Branch responders have served as the
- 16 state's frontline defense to incidents involving any potential
- biological or chemical acts of terrorism; and 17
- WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Branch, coordinating with 18
- other state agencies, has handled hundreds of responses to white 19
- powder scares and other potential biological/chemical acts of 20
- 21 terrorism; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to working closely with both state and 22
- federal agencies, the Emergency Services Branch works very closely 23
- with local governmental entities, such as county emergency 24
- management agencies, hazardous materials teams, fire departments, 25
- 26 law enforcement and health officials; and
