15 Youth Leadership Jackson, Headmaster's List 9-12th Grade; Ranked
16 4th in the graduation class; and Highest Academic Awards in Math,
17 Speech and Biology; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to her accomplishments, Miss Foshee
19 serves on the Mayor's Youth Council of Clinton and the Youth
20 Council at Wynndale Baptist Church, where she is a member; and

21 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize

23 beautiful, talented and intelligent women such as Miss Foshee:
