1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2 BROAD STREET HIGH SCHOOL "LADY JAGUARS" GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM AND 3 LONGTIME COACH WILLIE WASHINGTON FOR WINNING THEIR FIRST-EVER 4 CLASS 2A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, the long quest for the coveted "Gold Ball" trophy 6 finally came to a successful close for the Broad Street High 7 School, Shelby, Mississippi, "Lady Jaguars" Basketball Team on 8 Saturday, March 8, 2003, before a raucous crowd of 3,000 at the 9 Mississippi Coliseum, when they won their first-ever Class 2A 10 Girls State Championship with a decisive 70-49 victory over

11 Coldwater High School; and

12 WHEREAS, the success of the Broad Street Lady Jags did not go 13 unnoticed in the state; the team finished the year by ranking 14 eighth in the state in the girls poll, after posting an impressive 15 34-4 record; and

16 WHEREAS, with Ray Brooks winning the 1A title, it was the 17 first time ever that Bolivar County had two state champion 18 basketball teams in the same year; and

WHEREAS, "This is a dream come true" said longtime Lady Jags 19 Head Coach Willie Washington, who has spent 13 of his 34 years at 20 Broad Street coaching the girl's basketball team, and who 21 expressed his thanks to the community for supporting championship 22 basketball in the Delta; Coach Washington is a graduate of 23 Mississippi Valley State University and has coached football, 24 basketball and track at Broad Street since December 1968; Coach 25 Washington taught this team that offense wins ballgames but 26 defense wins championships; and 27

28 WHEREAS, 2002-2003 was a landmark season because the Lady 29 Jaguars had to travel and play their home games at Coahoma 30 Community College in Clarksdale because of renovations to their 31 gym; they finished with a perfect record inside their Division 32 3-2A, put together a 24-game consecutive winning streak at one 33 point in the season, and won the 2A North Half Regional Title 34 before advancing to the State Championship Tournament; and
