- 23 straight years and in her senior year leads with her highest
- 24 season average at 25.6 points per game; and
- 25 WHEREAS, LaToya Thomas' leadership on the floor and
- 26 willingness to work on all aspects of the game have placed her in
- 27 the top ten in many SEC categories, including scoring, offensive

- 28 rebounds, defensive rebounds, free-throw percentage, field goal

- 31 also been named a Wade Trophy Finalist, Naismith Player of the
