SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 620

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING GEORGE SPINKS FOR HIS
2 ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND FOR HIS EFFECTIVE LEADERSHIP AS
3 PRESIDENT OF THE PHI THETA KAPPA CHAPTER AT EAST MISSISSIPPI
4 COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

5 WHEREAS, George Spinks, a sophomore at East Mississippi
6 Community College, was selected as a member of the Phi Theta Kappa
7 All-Mississippi Academic Team; and

8 WHEREAS, George Spinks maintained a 4.0 grade point average
9 in 2002 and 2003; and

10 WHEREAS, George Spinks was a Golden Key Award Winner in 2003
11 and an All-USA Academic Team Nominee in 2003; and

12 WHEREAS, George Spinks made the President's List in 2002 and
13 2003 and the "National Dean's List" in 2002 and 2003; and

14 WHEREAS, in recognition of his leadership ability, George
15 Spinks was selected as the President of the Student Government
16 Association at East Mississippi Community College; and

17 WHEREAS, George Spinks was also chosen as President of the
18 Eta Upsilon Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa at East Mississippi
19 Community College; and

20 WHEREAS, under the leadership of George Spinks, the Eta
21 Upsilon Chapter attained a Five-Star Phi Theta Kappa Chapter
22 rating, the first in the 75-year history of East Mississippi
23 Community College; and

24 WHEREAS, the impressive intellect, effective leadership, and
25 commitment to excellence of George Spinks has earned him the
26 respect and admiration of his peers and the faculty at East
27 Mississippi Community College; and



28 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature to recognize and
29 commend the academic accomplishments and leadership of the youth
30 of the State of Mississippi:

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
32 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
33 we do hereby commend George Spinks for his academic
34 accomplishments and for his leadership of the Phi Theta Kappa
35 Chapter at East Mississippi Community College.
