SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 622

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE  
2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL  
3 NO. 2798, 2003 REGULAR SESSION, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE  
4 SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICIALS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-3,  
5 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE SALARY SCALE FOR TAX  
6 COLLECTORS AND TAX ASSESSORS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13,  
7 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF  
8 COUNTY BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-25,  
9 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF SHERIFFS AND  
10 TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY TO PAY AN  
11 ANNUAL SUPPLEMENT TO THE SHERIFF OF THE COUNTY UPON CERTAIN  
12 CONDITIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-36, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
13 INCREASE THE SALARIES OF JUSTICE COURT JUDGES; TO AMEND SECTION  
14 41-61-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARY  
15 ALLOWABLE TO CHIEF COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINERS AND CHIEF COUNTY  
16 MEDICAL EXAMINER INVESTIGATORS; TO AMEND SECTION 9-13-19,  
17 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF COURT  
18 REPORTERS; TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
19 INCREASE THE DAILY COMPENSATION AUTHORIZED FOR RIDING BAILIFFS; TO  
20 AMEND SECTION 25-11-125, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE  
21 BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO PAY THE REQUIRED EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION TO  
22 THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR ALL CIRCUIT AND  
23 CHANCERY CLERKS OF THE COUNTY; TO AMEND SECTIONS 9-11-2 AND  
24 19-19-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE NUMBER OF  
25 JUSTICE COURT JUDGES AND CONSTABLES SHALL NOT BE REDUCED IN ANY  
26 COUNTY AS A RESULT OF A POPULATION DECREASE BASED UPON THE 2000  
27 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS; TO REPEAL SECTION 25-3-5, MISSISSIPPI  
28 CODE OF 1972, WHICH ESTABLISHES THE SALARIES OF TAX ASSESSORS AND  
29 TAX COLLECTORS IN COUNTIES WHERE THE TWO OFFICES HAVE BEEN  
30 SEPARATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

31 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE  
32 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the following  
33 bill is hereby exempt from the timetable for consideration of  
34 bills provided by Joint Rule No. 40, and that consent is hereby  
35 given for further consideration of Senate Bill No. 2798, 2003  
36 Regular Session, entitled "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF  
37 CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICIALS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-3, MISSISSIPPI  
38 CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE SALARY SCALE FOR TAX COLLECTORS AND  
39 TAX ASSESSORS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,  
40 TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF COUNTY BOARDS OF  
41 SUPERVISORS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,



42 TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF SHERIFFS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF  
43 SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY TO PAY AN ANNUAL SUPPLEMENT TO THE  
44 SHERIFF OF THE COUNTY UPON CERTAIN CONDITIONS; TO AMEND SECTION  
45 25-3-36, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF  
46 JUSTICE COURT JUDGES; TO AMEND SECTION 41-61-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE  
47 OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARY ALLOWABLE TO CHIEF COUNTY MEDICAL  
48 EXAMINERS AND CHIEF COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER INVESTIGATORS; TO  
49 AMEND SECTION 9-13-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE  
50 SALARIES OF COURT REPORTERS; TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-31,  
51 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE DAILY COMPENSATION  
52 AUTHORIZED FOR RIDING BAILIFFS; TO AMEND SECTION 25-11-125,  
53 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO  
54 PAY THE REQUIRED EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'  
55 RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR ALL CIRCUIT AND CHANCERY CLERKS OF THE  
56 COUNTY; TO AMEND SECTIONS 9-11-2 AND 19-19-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF  
57 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE NUMBER OF JUSTICE COURT JUDGES AND  
58 CONSTABLES SHALL NOT BE REDUCED IN ANY COUNTY AS A RESULT OF A  
59 POPULATION DECREASE BASED UPON THE 2000 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS;  
60 TO REPEAL SECTION 25-3-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH  
61 ESTABLISHES THE SALARIES OF TAX ASSESSORS AND TAX COLLECTORS IN  
62 COUNTIES WHERE THE TWO OFFICES HAVE BEEN SEPARATED; AND FOR  
63 RELATED PURPOSES."
