1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING POPLARVILLE UPPER
2 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION INSTRUCTOR, RONNIE BURGE,
3 FOR THEIR THIRD STRAIGHT PRESIDENTIAL PHYSICAL FITNESS AWARD.

5 third straight year won State Champions in Mississippi for
6 Classification 3 (500-1,000 students) of the President's
7 Challenge; and

9 Fitness Award, awarded annually to schools showing excellence and
10 meeting high standards in physical education; and

11 WHEREAS, the total number of students in the school is 501
12 (Grades 3-5), and 111 students made "Presidential" this past year,
13 the second highest in the state; and

14 WHEREAS, 616 Poplarville Upper Elementary students have made
15 the Presidential Challenge in the past eight years; and

16 WHEREAS, Poplarville Elementary School's Physical Education
17 Instructor is Ronnie Burge, who is to be congratulated on his
18 students' achievement; and

19 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the
20 outstanding accomplishments of these students who have brought
21 honor to their school, their community and to the State of
22 Mississippi:
