SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 21

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE OF MR. JOHN SELF AND
2 EXPRESSING OUR DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HIS FAMILY.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. John Self, a native of Winona, Mississippi,
4 departed this life on July 28, 2002, causing great loss and sorrow
5 to his family and friends; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. John Self had just graduated from high school in
7 Westwood, California, and was only 19 years of age at the time of
8 his untimely death; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. John Self was an employee of the U.S. Forest
10 Service on fire duty when he was killed in the line of duty in the
11 Klamath National Forest; and

12 WHEREAS, on Arbor Day, February 14th, a tree will be planted
13 in honor of the memory of Mr. John Self; and

14 WHEREAS, the legacy and memory of Mr. John Self will live on
15 in the lives of those who knew and loved him, especially his
16 family: mother, Genia Self; father, Johnny Self; brothers, Waylon
17 Self and Gerald Logan; sisters, LaQue Self, Samantha Self and
18 Leslie Logan; and maternal grandparents, Gene and Faye Palmertree;

20 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Senate of the State of
21 Mississippi to commend the lives of outstanding Mississippians as
22 Mr. John Self, who lost their lives in serving and protecting
