SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 36

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF TE	≀RY,
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- 2 MISSISSIPPI, UPON THE CELEBRATION OF ITS 150TH ANNIVERSARY.
- 3 WHEREAS, the First Baptist Church in Terry, Mississippi, is
- 4 celebrating 150 years of ministry and has planned a 150th
- 5 Anniversary Celebration Weekend on Saturday, March 1, 2003, and
- 6 Sunday, March 2, 2003; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the First Baptist Church was constituted on
- 8 September 18, 1852, and was first called Friendship Baptist
- 9 Church; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the first church was located in New Town, a
- 11 community now known as Wynndale, 3.5 miles northwest of Terry, and
- 12 Reverend Jesse Woodall served as the first pastor; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the first Sunday School was organized in 1860 and
- 14 the church letter to the Central Association in 1866 indicated
- 15 that there were 31 white members and 21 black members; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in 1868, Friendship Church was moved from New Town
- 17 to Terry, and a house of worship was constructed in 1869 on a site
- 18 donated by Mr. and Mrs. J.J. Conway of Pike County, Mississippi;
- 19 and
- WHEREAS, in 1872, there were 41 members of the church, 33
- 21 enrolled in Sunday School, and available records show that the
- 22 church library consisted of 125 volumes; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the name of the church was changed to Terry Baptist
- 24 Church in 1878; the former church site in New Town was sold in
- 25 1888 for \$20.00; and the earliest budget available for the year
- 26 1895 was \$395.55; and

- 27 WHEREAS, in 1899, the large white frame building that served
- 28 for many years was built; this building was razed and a brick
- 29 sanctuary completed in 1955; a brick education building was
- 30 completed in 1963; and in 1978, a Family Life Center was
- 31 constructed; and
- 32 WHEREAS, the name of Terry Baptist Church was changed to
- 33 First Baptist Church on January 27, 1974. Renovation and
- 34 enlargement of the sanctuary and office suite, which was started
- in 1987, was completed in 1988. A dedication service was held
- 36 September 25, 1988; and
- 37 WHEREAS, current church statistics are: 1,081 total church
- 38 members; 562 Sunday School enrollment; 296 Sunday School average
- 39 attendance; and \$539,012.00 in total receipts; and
- 40 WHEREAS, current church leaders and personnel are: John H
- 41 Pace, Jr., Pastor; Todd Cole, Minister of Youth and Activities;
- 42 Jeff Cannon, Director of Music; Maxcine Brunson, Secretary; Rhonda
- 43 Mangold, Childcare Director; Toby Jones, Chairman of the Deacons;
- 44 and Leonard Homes, Custodian; and
- WHEREAS, the First Baptist Church has provided the citizens
- 46 of Terry, Mississippi, with many years of Christian guidance,
- 47 fellowship and worship to fulfill their religious needs:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 49 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend the First Baptist Church of
- 50 Terry, Mississippi, upon its 150th Anniversary and express our
- 51 appreciation for its many years of services to the citizens of
- 52 this state.
