SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 38

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MISS JENNIFER ADCOCK FOR HER REIGN AS
2 MISS MISSISSIPPI 2002.

3 WHEREAS, Jennifer Adcock, the daughter of Jesse and Janet
4 Adcock, was selected as Miss Mississippi 2002; and

5 WHEREAS, Jennifer Adcock was born in Biloxi, Mississippi, but
6 moved to Hattiesburg in 1994, where she graduated from Oak Grove
7 High School with special honors; and

8 WHEREAS, Jennifer Adcock's platform issue, early childhood
9 development, is the result of her commitment to educating parents
10 about the needs of their children from birth to school, to inform
11 them of resources available in the community and to advocate for
12 supporting existing programs and early childhood education
13 programs that are needed; and

14 WHEREAS, her community service is dear to her heart and not
15 created just for the pageant experience: her mother is a
16 Preschool Minister at First Baptist Church in Hattiesburg;
17 Jennifer has attended seminars and worked with her mother in the
18 area of early childhood development since about 12 years of age;
19 and Jennifer does hands-on volunteer work with several local and
20 school-sponsored parenting centers in Petal, Picayune and
21 Hattiesburg; and

22 WHEREAS, Jennifer Adcock is a Senior at the University of
23 Southern Mississippi and is majoring in Speech Communication where
24 she is on the Dean's List, the President's List, and is in the
25 Lambda Pi Eta Speech Communication Honor Society, the Delta Delta
26 Delta Sorority and the Speech Communication Association; and



27 WHEREAS, Jennifer Adcock has competed well in previous
28 pageants, being named Miss Southern 2001; Mississippi's Junior
29 Miss 1998; Talent Preliminary Winner and Overall Non-Finalist
30 Talent Winner at America's Junior Miss in Mobile, Alabama; and

31 WHEREAS, Jennifer Adcock participated in the Miss America
32 Pageant in September 2002, winning the Active International
33 Business Award and finishing as a Swimsuit Preliminary Winner and
34 a Top Ten Finalist; and

35 WHEREAS, the Senate wishes to pay a special tribute to a
36 remarkable young woman, Miss Jennifer Adcock, for her outstanding
37 representation of the state during her reign as Miss Mississippi:
